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BIO

Aurelio Di Virgilio (1995, Pescara) is a dancer and performer who lives and works between Rome and Milan. He graduated from the school of Piccolo Teatro of Milan - Luca Ronconi (2017).

His choreographic and performative research is focused on heterogeneous tools such as choreographic scores, somatic practices, plastic elements and drawings to access personal memories and to reflect on the present we are living. Bodies are invited to relate each others by reconsidering their identity and their gestural codes to get in touch with the other.

Since 2020 he has presented his works in theatres, museums and art foundations, including Cango – Cantieri Goldonetta (Florence), La Fondazione – Fondazione Nicola del Roscio (Rome), Nuovo Teatro delle Commedie (Livorno), Fondazione smART (Rome), Museo della Città (Livorno), Sala Santa Rita (Rome). It is part of the Prender-si cura 2021 residency program, curated by Ilaria Mancia at the Mattatoio (Rome). In 2022 he won the Più Erbacce research grant promoted in collaboration with BASE (Milan). He has collaborated as a performer for Collettivo Treppenwitz and as performer/assistant for Masako Matsushita on occasion of MOVING, a project sustained by Memorie Future, a cultural program organized by Fondazione Feltrinelli Triennale Milano and Terzo Paesaggio.

The dedication is for me a point in the story which represents in its brevity the completeness of the act. A microscopic and crystalline sign. The investigation, the performance and the installation (in the form of fragments) want to be an ode to the invisible, to all nocturnal, whispered communications. Through the creation of an archive in progress – currently made up of dedications, clay sculptures, books, fortune cookies – the intention is to define a place in which it could be possible to glimpse, evoke, imagine the life of the other.



LAND talks about the landscape as an unstable and changing territory, in which we are completely immersed. No longer something external to us, but something that is constantly generated and regenerated through us: a place articulated on a network of relationships, visible and invisible, which connect us to the outside and to other people. The focus of the research is on the way in which external information is detected and inserted within performer's inner landscape. In this solitary dimension, he has to build a code of gestures and gazes capable of defining an articulated network of real or imaginary relationships. The performance uses a carpet to define the place and the limit of the action: in this way we want to orient the fruition towards a precise and clear dimension, which over time can open up to the surrounding environment and allow the formation of an horizontal territory that can be shared. A place no longer lonely.








